



New Mexico FamilyPass Borrower Agreement

The Department of Cultural Affairs (DCA), the New Mexico State Library, and your local public library are pleased to offer patrons the opportunity to visit any of the DCA museums and historic sites free with the use of the New Mexico FamilyPass.

Check Out:

- Patrons must be in good standing with the public library in order to borrow the FamilyPass
- Patrons must have a library card.
- Patrons must be over the age of 18. Patrons who are under 18 will need a parent or guardian to sign the Borrower Agreement in order to check out a pass.
- The FamilyPass will admit up to 6 people.
- The FamilyPass may only be checked out once every 30 days.
- The FamilyPass can be borrowed for up to 21 days.

Check In:

- The FamilyPass should be returned only to the library location where the patron borrowed the pass.
- Patron should make every effort to return the pass in good condition. Please consider the next family who will borrow it, and keep the pass clean and dry.
- Return the pass to the Reference Desk staff. Do not return the pass in the book drop – this could lead to damage or loss of the pass.
- Overdue notices will be sent when the FamilyPass becomes overdue. The second notice will include the replacement cost of the pass, and the notification that the patron's account is suspended until the pass is returned.
- Please fill-out a short survey about your experience with the FamilyPass.
- Borrowers agree to reimburse the library \$25.00 for a lost or stolen FamilyPass.
